Southwest Airlines CEO, Gary Kelly, has requested that all Southwest Unions cosign a letter addressed to the President and the Congress of the United States. The letter states the position of our airline and all of its employees. The joint letter requests a clean extension of the CARES Act for the U.S. Airline Industry.
